Performance List - Express Yourself!!

Shorts/pants/skirts are fine, but remember you will be moving around. *You do not want to have to keep adjusting your clothing as you perform. Please no low-cut jeans or pants or excessively revealing clothing. Wear garments that won't make you self conscious about what people might accidentally see!

PLEASE NOTE: You will need to bring shoes that you can move well in for rehearsals, workshops and performances. This means no flip-flops, boots or 5-inch heels. In addition to your "Express Yourself" outfit, you will also need to bring black clothing. **There will also be a \$10.00 fee for materials. There will be a spot for students to recycle their music if they choose.**
