The list of suggested “stuff” for Drama camp is divided into two categories. The first category deals with clothes and materials you will need for daily rehearsals and workshops. The second category presents guidelines for your “performance costume.” Be creative! Please, there is no need to spend “big bucks” for anything on this list!

Rehearsal List (everyday)

Clothes that allow for movement and action

- Sweats, leotards, loose fitting clothes
- Tennis or dance shoes.
- A notebook and pencils

PLEASE NOTE: You will need to bring shoes that you can move well in for rehearsals, workshops and performances. This means no flip-flops, boots or 5-inch heels. In addition to your “Express Yourself” outfit, you will also need to bring black clothing.

Put together an outfit that expresses who you are and what you believe in. Think tasteful, yet unique. Please do not wear jewelry, as that may interfere with your movement/activity.

Shorts/pants/skirts are fine, but remember you will be moving around. *You do not want to have to keep adjusting your clothing as you perform. Please no low-cut jeans or pants or excessively revealing clothing. Wear garments that won't make you self conscious about what people might accidentally see!
