



A native of South Dakota, Ms. Zander is currently a piano faculty member at St. Joseph's School of Music in St. Paul and maintains an independent piano studio in St. Peter. An active performer and teacher, Ms. Zander was awarded both the Prairie Lakes Regional Arts Council/McKnight Foundation Emerging Artist Grant and the Piano Technicians Guild Teacher Continuing Education Scholarship in 2008 for continued Dalcroze Eurhythmics study at the Marta Sanchez Dalcroze Training Center at Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. In 2007, she was the recipient of both the Minnesota Music Teachers Association (MMTA) Teacher Enrichment Grant and the Music Teachers National

Association (MTNA) Professional Development Grant. Ms. Zander can be heard performing as a soloist through the Thursday Musical Society and as a freelance accompanist in the Twin Cities Metro and Mankato/St.Peter areas.
